Facility Use Guidelines

- YMCA Members 18+ may use the outdoor pool free of charge, and may bring up to 5 guests/ membership free of charge.
- All members must present their membership card at the outdoor pool check-in station.
- Guest Fees are \$15/family.
- All guests must present a photo id and complete a guest waiver
- All members and guests are screened against the National Sex Offender Registry using RAPTOR technology

Safety Rules for the Pool

|---------------|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Age 6 & under | Must be accompanied in the water by an adult, even after passing swim test. Adult must be within arms reach of the child at all times. |
| Ages 7-10 | Must have an adult on pool deck |
| Ages 7-15 | Children who do not pass the shallow end swim test must be accompanied by in the water by an adult. An adult must be within arms reach of child. |
- Lifejackets are available for non-swimmers
 - Pool floats are not permitted
 - Members/Guests are asked to follow the directions of lifeguards at all times.
